Starting and finishing from the start/finish line of the Hy-Vee Women's 5K and Half Marathon, the Hy-Vee KidsFit One Mile Fun Run is an event for children ages 5 to 15 years old. The race is open to every ability level who wants to be a part of the morning's activities. Registered participants will receive a Hy-Vee KidsFit t-shirt at packet pick-up and a Hy-Vee KidsFit finisher medal when they cross the finish line.





Your Race Course, running through two states!

The course of this year's event is flat, fast, and scenic and will start and finish on the corner of 12th Street and Mike Fahey Street in the heart of downtown, Omaha, NE.


The course tour begins as you pass Charles Schwab Field, and continue along Abbott Parkway to the Missouri River as you will cross the Bob Kerrey Pedestrian Bridge for the first time. Athletes will then run along the Trail System South to the Council Bluff's Athletic Fields, where you will make a U-turn to begin the second half of your Half Marathon course.

Runners will continue on the Trail System heading north back to the Bob Kerrey Pedestrian Bridge on their way back to the start on 12th Street.

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

At this time the City of Omaha does not have any COVID Restrictions in place. Have a great race!

COURSE SUPPORT

Athletes will have six different water stations on course for your support & convenience. Locations will offer water, Gatorade, ice, bananas, and energy gels at our 3rd stop at or near mile 6 with portable restrooms!

PARKING

There is plenty of On-Street & Off-Street parking for this event in and around the start/finish Line. The entire area surrounding Charles Schwab Field has plenty of parking garages in this event's downtown area, making this a very convenient location to host an event at this location!

WALKING / STROLLER DIVISION

That's correct! The Omaha Women's Half Marathon & 5K presented by Hy-Vee, will offer a walker & stroller division for our new mom's and their kids. Remember, the Half Marathon has a 4-hour time limit for walking or running with your baby stroller.

MOTHERS TENTS

The Omaha Women's Half Marathon & 5K presented by Hy- Vee, will offer two mother tents for privacy and convenience. Our first tent will be near the start/finish line area, and our second location will be on the half marathon course at or around the mile 6 water stop. Each location will offer the following: a 10' x10' pop-up tent with side walls for privacy, 1 table, 4 chairs, an ice chest with bottled water & Gatorade, 1 trash can, and a female volunteer for assistance.

COURSE TIME LIMITS

The Omaha Women's Half Marathon & 5K presented by Hy- Vee will have a 4-Hour time limit for the Half Marathon event. While the 5K Road Race has no time restrictions.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

The Omaha Women's Half Marathon & 5K presented by Hy-Vee will have EMS units on the course and at the start finish line for your safety.
